Need help deciding what to shred? Consider these:

KEEP THESE ITEMS THIS LONG

Bank

Checking Statements 7 years
Deposit slips (after bank verification) Shred
Passbook 7 years

Financial

Annuities 4 years after account is closed
Disability Insurance 4 years after account is closed
Life Insurance Permanent
Safety Deposit Box 4 yrs after box account closes

Household

Appraisal Until house is sold
Deed/Title Keep copy 4 years after selling
Homeowner's Insurance 4 years after expiration
Property Taxes Until house is sold

Medical

Bills 4 years or until claim settles
Immunization Schedule Permanent
Allergy Information Permanent

What to keep in your Safety Deposit Box

Birth Certificates	Citizenship Papers
Marriage Certificates	Adoption Papers
Divorce Decrees	Wills
Death Certificates	Deeds
Automobile Titles	Household Inventory (including pictures)
Veteran's Papers	Stock & Bond Certificates
