From I-680 take the Dodge Street East exit, take Dodge Street to 84th Street, at 84th Street take a right (south), go up the hill and take the first left (east). Children's Hospital will be on the left side of the street. Turn left into the Children's circle drive and you will see the entrance to the parking garage. The parking garage is located beneath the hospital. You may park anywhere in visitor parking. If the lot is full, Children's Security will direct you to additional parking.

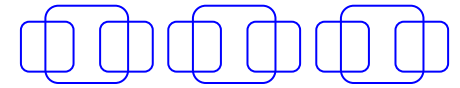
Take the elevator in the parking garage to the third floor. When you get off the elevator, take a left. This will take you directly to the Glow Auditorium.
