Family Navigation

Provided by Family Organizations

Criteria:

- Available for any Nebraska parent/guardian needing mental/behavioral health support for youth age 0-18 (nonstate ward)
- Available within 24 to 72 hours after a Helpline referral

Services:

- Assist family in identifying families strengths
- Assist family in setting goals
- Assist family in identifying existing community-based services.
- Provide family support
- Listen to family and provide an understanding ear



Post Adoption/Guardianship Services

Provided by Right Turn

Criteria:

• Eligibility for services includes families formed through international, domestic, step-parent, and foster care adoption (0-21) along with guardianships formed from Nebraska state care (0-19)

Services:

- Permanency Support
- Peer Support
- Service Referrals
- Assist family in identifying existing community-based services
- Support Groups & Training
