

- Champion of safety requirements





- Thanks




Team Communication Tools

- Group texts
- Group emails
- Replies to Team Coordinator (no Reply to All)
- Shared calendar

Direct communication with patient or caregiver for specifics

Challenges

- Finding the best communication channels
- Communication snafus/tech proficiencies
- Accepting no's graciously team coordinator's job
- Regular check-ins with patient or primary caregiver to make needed adjustments
- Removing unsuitable team members



Rewards

- Reduced patient/caregiver isolation opens their world
- Helps to avoid caregiver burnout
- Team members feel really useful
- Deeper relationships between patient/caregiver and team members
- Friendships among team members
